## St. Martin of Tours Cemetery

- 1. Cemetery hours are from dawn until dusk
- 2. Flowers and decorations are permitted at graves and must be placed in front of the monument in a disposable container.
- 3. Trees and shrubs are placed throughout the Cemetery by the Cemetery for overall beauty and serenity of the grounds. Individual graves are not permitted to have trees or shrubs. Any such tree or shrub not approved by the Cemetery may be removed without notice to the lot owner.
- 4. Devotional lights of any type are prohibited in the Cemetery
- 5. Glass of any kind is prohibited.
- 6. Decorations are the responsibility of the owner and must be placed so that they do not interfere with cemetery maintenance.
- 7. The Cemetery reserves the right to remove all objects whose appearance and condition warrant removal and/or violate the Cemetery's rules and regulations. The Cemetery also will not be liable for any flower or decoration removed or lost by any cause.
  - a. Cemetery cleanup schedule follows:
    - i. Christmas- All decorations, wreaths etc. will be cleared by February 1. Anything that you wish to keep must be removed prior to that date.
    - ii. Easter- All decorations will be cleared two weeks from the date. Anything that you wish to keep must be removed prior to that date.
    - iii. The grounds will be pruned and cleaned twice a year in the Spring and Fall.
    - iv. Items not allowed to be placed on a lot within the Cemetery include, but are not limited to, the following: shepherd's hooks, standup decorations, coping, curbing, decorative rocks, fencing, hedging, grave mounds, borders or enclosures. No decorations of any type are permitted in trees or Cemetery plantings.
    - v. Flags may be placed on graves on Memorial Day, the Fourth of July, Flag Day, and Veterans Day. Flags should be kept to 12" by 18" in size or smaller. Flags are subject to removal by Cemetery within ten (10) days of the Holiday.
- 8. Monuments are limited to 30 inches per grave site.
- 9. Monuments may bot be placed on the lot until foundation charge has been paid.
